**High Point Pony** – must show in halter class, one in hand or riding fun class and one in hand or riding obstacle class, and one regular riding class. Pony may be shown by more than one exhibitor.

**High Point Horse** – must show in halter class, one in-hand or riding fun class, one in-hand or riding obstacle class and one regular riding class. Horse may be shown by more than one exhibitor.

**High Point Youth 8 and under** – exhibitor must show in showmanship, equitation or horsemanship, in hand or lead line obstacle and one fun class. Exhibitor may show more than one animal.

**High Point Youth 9 – 13** – exhibitor must show in showmanship, equitation or horsemanship, in-hand or riding obstacle, one fun class and one performance class. Exhibitor may show more than one animal.

**High Point Youth 14-18** – Exhibitor must show in showmanship, equitation or horsemanship, in-hand or riding obstacle, and one fun class and one performance class.
